As I reflect on the past year, I am deeply grateful and filled with hope. Your unwavering support has been at the heart of our mission at Natural High, and I'm excited to share the progress we've made together.

Over 25 years ago, after losing my two younger brothers, Steve and Eric, I started a non-profit to share our story and help others. In those early days, I visited high schools with a slide projector, often joined by a few friends, sharing our stories to school assemblies.

Last year, we reached 2.9 million students across all 50 states—over 10% of the U.S. 6th-12th grade population. This milestone is huge for our small but dedicated team, and we couldn't have done it without you.

Our mission is to provide effective drug prevention education, through Natural High, to every child in the US.

The fentanyl crisis remains a serious challenge. At Natural High, we're empowering young people to make healthy, drug-free choices. Thanks to your support, our program is reaching more kids than ever, giving them the tools to pursue their passions instead of turning to harmful substances.

In April, I spoke to over 600 seniors at Olympian High School in Chula Vista, where students raised \$11,000 for Natural High and educated their community about the dangers of fentanyl. Their commitment shows the powerful impact we can achieve together.

I'm also eager to introduce our new digital course for parents, "Building a Natural High Family." This course will equip parents to have honest conversations about substance use, strengthening family connections and helping keep kids substance-free.

Your support has made all of this possible. Thank you for being a vital part of the Natural High movement. Together, we're changing lives, one child and family at a time, and we're excited to continue reaching even more kids with your ongoing commitment.

COMMUNITY PARTNERS HELP SAVE LIVES

Natural High's impact goes far beyond our team, thanks to the support of educators, parents, and coalitions. They help spread our message by using our resources in their own communities.

Our fentanyl prevention collateral are displayed across the country, and community meetings have shared our fentanyl prevention video. Coalitions, sheriff's offices, and local organizations have also helped spread our content on social media and in their areas, saving lives along the way.

We're especially proud to partner with Texas A&M, where our fentanyl prevention video is featured. And thanks to the Amara Rose Foundation, 9,000 drink stickers with QR codes linking to our fentanyl prevention video are being distributed to prevent fentanyl use.

Through these partnerships, our message keeps growing, reaching more people and inspiring action.

INSPIRING SENIORS

Jon presented to 600 seniors at Olympian High School in Chula Vista in May. For the 2023-24 school year, the senior leadership committee chose Natural High as the focus of their yearlong fundraising campaign to provide ongoing substance abuse prevention in our nation.



These remarkable young people spent the entire school year explaining the dangers of substance use and fentanyl poisoning in their community.
